a) Carefully take up the Victorian porch floor, carefully clean and set aside all tiles for reuse. All tiles should be carefully labelled to allow

All labelling system needs to be reversible on completion. Allow for 20% replacement of tiles to match and for cutting them

Carefully excavate, under the archaeologist's watching brief, down to new construction level for the reduced floor levels for the floor construction. Clear away the excavated material following scrutiny by

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
