

St Peter's church is now consulting on its revised scheme to improve disabled access. This entails lowering of the floor in the south porch to create level access into the church, the adjustment of the path from the south porch to create a gentle slope to the externally-accessed disabled WC, and the introduction of a new drain and soakaway.
